

## **Class A Misdemeanor**

### **Class A Misdemeanor Penalties – New York**

- **Up to 1 year of jail**
- Intermittent imprisonment
- Split sentence of both jail and 6 years probation or 1 year conditional discharge where the jail portion is up to 60 days or intermittent imprisonment of up to 4 months PL [60.01](#), [65.00](#)
- **Probation for 6 years**
- Interim probation supervision
- **Conditional discharge** for 1 year or unconditional discharge PL [60.01](#), [65.05](#), [65.20](#)
- If a sex offense and the victim was under 18 or there is a prior conviction for a sex offense, sex offender registration may apply and HIV testing may be required. If the victim was under 18 or there is a level 3 SORA designation, there may be restriction from school grounds and certain other areas PL [65.10](#)
- Fine of up to \$1,000, \$50 DNA database fee
- \$175 **surcharge** (\$180 in a town or village), and a crime victim assistance fee of \$25 (unless restitution or reparation is being made)
